

Map your family's history of hereditary ATTR (hATTR) amyloidosis




Chart your family's health history

This worksheet can help you map your family's health history to see who may be at risk for hATTR amyloidosis.

hATTR amyloidosis—an inherited condition

hATTR amyloidosis is a rare, inherited condition, with initial symptoms typically appearing from the mid-20s to the mid-60s. Individuals with hATTR amyloidosis can have a range of symptoms that may not seem connected. Symptoms can **vary widely** among people with the condition, even within families. If one parent has hATTR amyloidosis, each child will have a **50% chance of inheriting the genetic variant**, or change, that may cause this condition.



A family member may inherit the transthyretin (TTR) gene variant, but having the variant does not necessarily mean that they will develop hATTR amyloidosis. Completing this worksheet with your family members can help educate them about hATTR amyloidosis and how it is passed down through generations. You can use the other materials within The Bridge[®] Kit to learn about the cause and symptoms of the condition.

They may recommend you work with a genetic counselor, who can help you and your family learn more about the testing process and if a genetic test may be right for you.


